We are so grateful to the Global Church's response to this epidemic that saw a number of initiatives being put together to minister to those affected in Liberia, Guinea and Sierra Leone.





Cape Verde Islands also experienced a volcanic eruption that saw many people displaced and homes and infrastructure destroyed. We continue to pray for those affected in this situation.

HIV and AIDS continues to be the biggest challenge on the Africa Region. Many lives are still being lost to this pandemic. Nazarene Compassionate Ministries in partnership with other organizations continues to create ways to minister to those affected and infected. Some of the initiatives include the care of orphans and widows through various initiatives. Our Child Development programmes serve as key centres where affected children are ministered to. We thank God for all the Sponsors who give towards this important ministry.

Our agricultural projects and gardens continue to provide for the families affected by way of nutrition and in some cases extra money to help meet other needs.

Water, for most parts of Africa, is a scarce commodity and many communities struggle to access clean water for domestic use. The need to provide wells continue to grow. We thank God for the support we receive from our friends in helping us provide wells and good sanitation in these communities. The need for wells is daunting and we continue to pray for support for this much needed resource.

Other highlights in 2014 include growing partnerships with Nazarene Compassionate Ministries Canada. Their support for our programmes in Malawi has seen the establishment of 6 Child Development Centres, provision of water wells, as well as funding conservation farming programmes in that country.





Gender Based Violence and Human Trafficking issues are becoming more and more visible as awareness campaigns spread across Africa. We praise God for rescued victims who are now being rehabilitated in a number of programmes on the Africa Region.

Our partnership with Intel Corporation continued in 2014 with Mayewane Nazarene Primary School receiving 25 Classmate Laptops and two 2 teacher's laptops for their computer literacy programme. We are looking forward to continued support in the coming years.

One of our highlights in 2014 was the visit by the Japan NCM team to explore partnership opportunities with NCM Africa. Great plans were drawn and we are hoping that opportunities will open up for support of the many programmes that we have on the Africa Region.

Sponsorship for children, both pastor's kids and Child Development is one of our key deliverables on the Africa Region. Child Development Ministries continue to grow across Africa and new centres are being started as more and more children who need help come to our attention. We continue to appeal for more and more sponsors to reach out in support for this important ministry.

I would like to thank our partners who have carried us through this challenging year.
