Kafti, which means firefly in the T'boli language, is a non-government organization based in Tokyo, Japan whose aim is not only to support the indigenous T'boli people, but also to promote agro-forestry to restore the tribe's natural woodland habitat, which has lost 90% of the forest trees due to illegal logging. T'boli Women are known as Dream Weavers, weaving sacred, intricate cloths made into many products sold to help sustain and develop their community. The products will be on hand for display and sale. ALL proceeds from the sale will go to the T'boli Tribe.
